### SAUDI ARABIA - ALERT SANCTIONS ON MISCLASSIFICATION

Saudi Arabia Customs Authorities and SASO have alerted on **reiterated mistakes and deliberated bad practices** on classification of goods imported to Saudi Arabia with the aim to avoid issuance and control of Certificates of Conformity.

Classification under a generic code "OTHER" missing an associated technical regulation when a specific HS CODE and applicable standards are available for a certain product will be sanctioned with 2000 SAR (approx.470 EUR).

The following SGS services are aimed to ensure correct issuance of Certificates of Conformity (CoCs) and facilitate import clearance:

- Product registration in SABER (database population)
- Harmonization of European to Saudi Classification (12 digits)
- Shipment Certificates of Conformity (CoC)
